Health Care Reform (HCR)

On March 23rd, President Obama signed health reform into Law. So exactly what is Health Care Reform? If you are like most Americans, you probably don't know exactly what this means or how this will affect you.

According to the White House, Health Care Reform will make health Care more affordable, make health insurers more accountable, expand health care coverage to all Americans and make the health care system sustainable stabilizing family budgets, the federal budget and the economy.

- Make Insurance affordable by providing the largest middle class
- It will end discrimination against Americans

- Set up a new competitive health insurance market giving millions of Americans the same choices of insurance that members of Congress will have

- Put our budget and economy on a more stable path by reducing the deficit by more than \$100 billion over the next 10 years- and more than \$1 trillion over the second decade- by cutting government over spending and reining in waste, fraud and abuse.

What does the HCR Mean to Me?

If you have employer-sponsored coverage: Any lifetime caps on how much your health plans will cover, often set between \$1 million and \$5 million, will be eliminated in both group and individual

health plans starting later this year. If you have a small business, starting this year you may be eligible for new tax credits that would cover up to 35% of health-insurance premiums for business that have less

than 25 employees. If you are uninsured, over the next 10 years, the bill will extend coverage to an estimated 32 million people who would otherwise lack coverage. Learn more, www.HealthReform.gov.

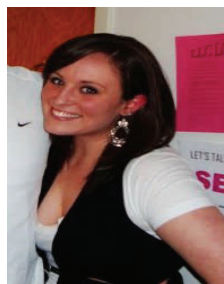
